



VACCINES AND SCHEDULES IN WHICH THEY ARE NORMALLY GIVEN:

2 months old: Pediarix #1 (DTaP, IPV, Hep B), Hib #1, Prevar #1, Rotavirus #1

4 months old: Pediarix #2 (DTaP, IPV, Hep B), Hib #2, Pevnar #2, Rotavirus #2

6 months old: Pediarix #3 (DTaP, IPV, Hep B), Hib #3, Pevnar #3

12 months old: MMR #1, Varivax #1, Hep A #1

15 months old: Hib #4, PCV

18 months old: DTaP, Hep A #2

2 years old: Hep A #2 (if not given prior)

4 to 5 years old: MMR #2, Varivax #2, DTaP #5, IPV #4

5+ years old: Varivax #2 (if not given prior)

11 years old: TDaP #1, Menactra, HPV (offered)

12+ years old: Hep A (if not given prior), HPV (offered), Varivax (as needed), TDaP #2, Menactra

Flu Vaccinations: Available to all children six months and older.

LIST OF VACCINES AND THEIR ABBREVIATIONS:

DTaP: Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (under age 7)

TDaP: Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Age 7 and up)

IPV: Polio Vaccine

Hep A: Hepatitis A

Hep B: Hepatitis B

Hib: Haemophilus Influenzae Type B

HPV: Human Papilloma Virus Vaccine

Menactra: Meningococcal Vaccine

MMR: Measles, Mumps and Rubella

PCV: Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine

Pevnar: Pneumococcal Vaccine

Rotavirus: Rotavirus Vaccine

Varivax: Varicella Vaccine (chicken pox)
