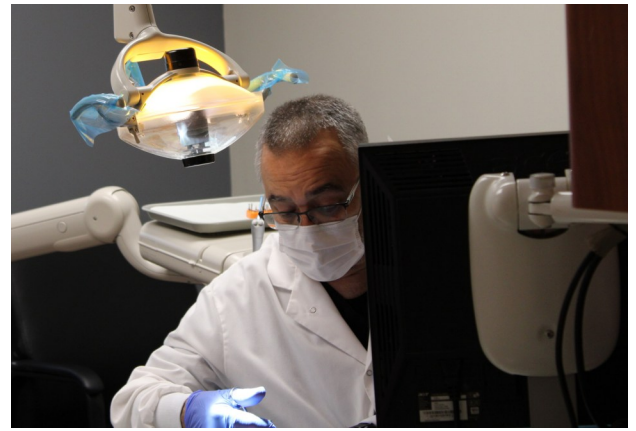

Essential Functions of Position:

Conduct health assessments of dental patients at GMHC and perform all clinical procedures, with the highest standard of care. Perform the clinical procedures (outlined below) within the guidelines established by the Missouri Dental Association and American Dental Association (MDA and ADA). Procedures performed by the Dentist include, but are not limited to the following:

- **Basic Diagnostic Procedures:** Periodic, limited, & comprehensive oral evaluation, intraoral radiographs, panoramic radiographs, Conebeam
- **Preventive Procedures:** Prophylaxis adult prophylaxis, child topical fluoride application, sedative fillings
- **Restorative Procedures:** Resin and amalgam fillings, crowns
- **Endodontics:** Anterior, bicuspid, and molar root canal therapy
- **Pediatrics:** Stainless steel crowns, pulpotomy & pulpectomy, nitrous oxide analgesia
- **Periodontics:** Diagnosis and management of treatment completed by the hygienist
- **Prosthodontics Removable:** Full and partial dentures, including interim, immediate, and final prosthesis
- **Prosthodontics Fixed:** Crown/Bridge
- **Oral Surgery:** Extraction of erupted tooth or exposed root, surgical removal of erupted tooth, alveoloplasty
- **Other Specialty Privileges:** Invisalign, dental implants, pediatric general anesthesia, removal of impacted tooth – soft tissue, removal of impacted tooth – partially bony
- **Management of patient care:** Management of patient care, including referral to the appropriate specialist for those unable to receive treatment at GMHC.
